1 **AN ACT** *to affect* 1997 Wisconsin Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt) and 1997 Wisconsin
2 Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt); **relating to:** the effective date of the requirement
3 that entities that provide care for children or adults conduct background
4 investigations of their current employees.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 1997 Wisconsin Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt) is amended to read:
6 [1997 Wisconsin Act 27] Section 9423 (9ptt) BACKGROUND INVESTIGATIONS OF
7 CURRENT EMPLOYES. The amendment of sections 48.685 (2) (ag) (intro.) and 50.065 (2)
8 (ag) (intro.) of the statutes takes effect on the first day of the ~~24th~~ 28th month
9 beginning after publication.
10 **SECTION 2.** 1997 Wisconsin Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt), as last amended by 1999
11 Wisconsin Act (this act), is repealed.

3 (a) If 1999 Wisconsin Act (Assembly Bill 133) is enacted into law, if 1997
4 Wisconsin Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt), is repealed by that act and if that repeal takes
5 effect on or after the effective date of this paragraph, then the repeal of 1997
6 Wisconsin Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt), by this act takes effect on the date on which
7 1997 Wisconsin Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt), is repealed by 1999 Wisconsin Act
8 (Assembly Bill 133).

9 (b) If 1999 Wisconsin Act (Assembly Bill 133) is enacted into law, if 1997
10 Wisconsin Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt), is repealed by that act and if that repeal takes
11 effect before the effective date of this paragraph, then the amendment of 1997
12 Wisconsin Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt), by this act and the repeal of 1997 Wisconsin
13 Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt), by this act are void.

14 (c) If neither paragraph (a) nor paragraph (b) applies, then the repeal of 1997
15 Wisconsin Act 27, section 9423 (9ptt), by this act is void.
