1. This draft includes the first five items you sent to me. I will be out of the office until August 4 so I wanted you to have what is done so far. I will redraft to include the remaining five items, plus any new items available for drafting, when I return.

2. Do you want to amend s. 108.22 (1) (b), stats., to provide that if the due date of a payment under s. 108.15 (5) (b) or 108.151 (5) (f), stats., falls on a Saturday, Sunday or a legal state or federal holiday, the due date is changed to the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal state or federal holiday? If not, the general rule as provided in s. 990.001 (4) (b) and (c), stats., will apply. Note that use of the term "legal holiday" can be problematic because it includes some days under s. 895.20, stats., and federal law when state offices are open for business.

3. The latest version of the appropriation schedule in the budget bill incorrectly shows the appropriation under s. 20.445 (1) (nb), stats., as continuing. In fact, it is an annual appropriation. Therefore, no moneys are authorized to be spent from this appropriation unless amounts are placed in the schedule. This draft contains appropriation blanks to be used for that purpose. I will fill in the blanks in a subsequent redraft if you will give me the appropriate dollar figures. Please note that since the budget bill repeals and recreates the appropriation schedule, in the event that this draft becomes law before the budget bill is enacted, the budget act will eliminate any appropriation made by this draft. Therefore, you may wish to consider seeking inclusion of this appropriation in the budget bill itself.
