1 **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state  
 2 of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Public Defenders Association, WFT/AFT,  
 3 Local 4822, AFL-CIO, for the <sup>1999-2001</sup> ~~1997-99~~ biennium, covering employes in the  
 4 public defenders collective bargaining unit, and authorizing an expenditure of  
 5 funds.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

1999-2001

This proposal is introduced under section 111.92 (1) of the statutes. The proposal ratifies the collective bargaining contract for state employes in the public defenders collective bargaining unit negotiated for the ~~1997-99~~ biennium under the State Employment Labor Relations Act. Currently, statutory program supplement appropriations fund the costs of collective bargaining agreements to the extent that they exceed budgeted costs. The proposal authorizes expenditure of moneys from those appropriations to fund the cost of this agreement.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
