This bill eliminates the court fees that a person who petitions a court for a harassment TRO or injunction must pay and provides that the subject of the order or injunction would pay the costs if he or she violates the order or injunction. This is similar to the provisions that presently exist for domestic abuse TRO's and injunctions. In 1999, there were an estimated 4,200 harassment actions filed in the circuit courts. The total court costs assessed when filing this type of action is \$124. If a person filing this action asks to have the fees waived because of indigency the court may do so if it determines that the person is indigent. The state's share of these fees is \$94 and the county's share is \$30. Various surchanges are part of the state's share including the circuit court automation fee, the court support services fee and the justice information fee. It is impossible to predict how much revenue will be lost to the state and county because it is not known how often these fees are currently waived or how often the orders and injunctions are violated. For example purposes only, if 50% of the harassment action filed presently paid the fee an estimated \$197,400 would be lost to the state and 63,000 to the county under this bill. It is also expected that once the fee is eliminated additional actions will be filed in the circuit court. These actions are handled both by judges and court commissioners. Judges are paid for by the state while court commissioners are paid for by the county. What the exact caseload increase would be is impossible to predict with the data available.
