1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 10 delete lines 5 to 19 and substitute:

3 "SECTION 2m. 101.123 (2) (ar) of the statutes is created to read:

4 101.123 (2) (ar) 1. Notwithstanding par. (a) and sub. (3) and except as provided

5 in subd. 2., no person may smoke in the state capitol building or ~~at~~ the state capitol

6 ~~grounds.~~

7 2. Subdivision 1. does not apply to ~~the governor's office,~~ any office space that

8 is assigned to a state senator or state representative to the assembly ~~or any room that~~

9 ~~is kept by the attorney general, lieutenant governor or supreme court.~~

10 SECTION 3g. 101.123 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

11 101.123 (4) (a) 1. Except as provided in ~~subd.~~ subds. 2. and 2m., a person in

12 charge or his or her agent may designate smoking areas in the places where smoking

, as long as all individuals who smoke in the office space do so in a respectful manner and address one another as "Mr.", "Mrs.", "Miss", "Ms.", "Sir", or "Ma'am", as appropriate

1 is regulated under sub. (2) (a) unless a fire marshal, law, ordinance or resolution  
2 prohibits smoking.

3 **SECTION 3r.** 101.123 (4) (a) 2m. of the statutes is created to read:

4 101.123 (4) (a) 2m. A person in charge or his or her agent may not designate  
5 the entire state capitol building as a smoking area or designate any area where  
6 smoking is prohibited in the state capitol building under sub. (2) (ar) 1. as a smoking  
7 area.”.

8 **2.** Page 3, line <sup>6</sup>1: after “(ar)” insert “1.”.

9 **3.** Page 3, line <sup>12</sup>7: after “(ar)” insert “1.”.

10 **4.** Page 3, line <sup>18</sup>10: after “(ar)” insert “1.”.

11 **5.** Page <sup>4</sup>3, line <sup>3</sup>28: after “(ar)” insert “1.”.

12 **6.** Page 4, line <sup>13</sup>8: after “(ar)” insert “1.”.
