Section 1. 15.06 (1) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

15.06 (1) (f) 1. In this paragraph:

- a. "Floorperiod day" means any day of a regularly scheduled floorperiod.
- b. "Floorperiod month" means any calendar month in which there is a floorperiod day.
- 2. If the senate does not confirm or reject the nomination of a member of the public service commission by the first floorperiod day of the 4th floorperiod month beginning after the date on which the governor submits the nomination to the senate, the member shall be appointed to the commission by the governor without the consent of the senate.
