1 **AN ACT to amend** 341.08 (2) (c), 341.11 (1) and 341.335 (title); and **to create**  
2 341.08 (2) (cm), 341.335 (1m) and 349.02 (2) (c) of the statutes; **relating to:**  
3 vehicle color and motor vehicle registration and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4 **SECTION 1.** 341.08 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:  
5 341.08 (2) (c) A description of the vehicle, including make, model, color  
6 identification number and any other information which the department may  
7 reasonably require for proper identification of the vehicle. An application for a  
8 motorcycle or for a vehicle registered at a gross weight of more than 8,000 pounds is  
9 not required to include the vehicle color in the description of the vehicle.

10 **SECTION 2.** 341.08 (2) (cm) of the statutes is created to read:

1           341.08 (2) (cm) A place for the applicant to indicate whether the color of the  
2 vehicle being registered has changed from the color specified on the certificate of  
3 registration and, if so, the new color.

4           **SECTION 3.** 341.11 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

5           341.11 (1) Except as provided in sub. (2) the department upon registering a  
6 vehicle shall issue and deliver to the owner a certificate of registration. The  
7 certificate shall contain the name, residence and address of the owner; a brief  
8 description of the vehicle, including its color; the registration number assigned; and  
9 the date of expiration of registration. The certificate shall be in such form and may  
10 contain such additional information as the department deems advisable. A  
11 certificate for a motorcycle or for a vehicle registered at a gross weight of more than  
12 8,000 pounds is not required to include the vehicle color in the description of the  
13 vehicle.

14           **SECTION 4.** 341.335 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

15           **341.335 (title) Notice of change of address or, name or vehicle color.**

16           **SECTION 5.** 341.335 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

17           341.335 (1m) No person is required to notify the department before the next  
18 renewal of registration for the vehicle that a vehicle's color has been changed from  
19 the color stated in the most recent application for registration of the vehicle.

20           **SECTION 6.** 349.02 (2) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

21           349.02 (2) (c) Notwithstanding par. (a), a law enforcement officer may not stop  
22 a vehicle solely because the vehicle's color differs from the color stated in the  
23 application for registration of that vehicle. This paragraph does not limit the  
24 authority of a law enforcement officer to issue a citation for improper registration of  
25 a vehicle whose color differs from the color stated in the application for registration

2 for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 7. Initial applicability.**

4 (1) This act first applies to applications for registration of vehicles submitted  
5 to the department of transportation on the effective date of this subsection.

6 **SECTION 8. Effective date.**

7 (1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 4th month beginning after  
8 publication or on July 1, 2000, whichever is later.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 ✓ 1. Page 1, line 3: before "and providing a penalty" insert ", making an  
3 appropriation".

4 ✓ 2. Page 3, line 2: after that line insert:

5 **"SECTION 6g. Nonstatutory provisions.**

6 (1) Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) (e) of the statutes, in submitting  
7 information under section 16.42 of the statutes for the purpose of the 2001-03  
8 biennial budget bill, the department of transportation shall submit information  
9 concerning the appropriation under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes as though  
10 the amounts appropriated to the department under that appropriation for fiscal year  
11 2000-01 were \$37,500 less than the amounts in the schedule.

12 **SECTION 6m. Appropriation changes.**

1 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation  
2 to the department of transportation under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes, as  
3 affected by the acts of 1999, the dollar amount is increased by \$37,500 for fiscal year  
4 2000-01 to reflecting vehicle color on motor vehicle registration.".

5 ✓ 3. Page 3, line 6: delete lines 6 to 8 and substitute:

6 SECTION 8m. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the first day of the 4th  
7 month beginning after publication or on July 1, 2000, whichever is later, except as  
8 follows:

9 3-6 (1) SECTION 6m of this act takes effect on the day after publication.".
