This bill discontinues the ^{occupational} tax on owners of domestic mink. The proceeds of the tax are now used for research on ^{the breeding and raising of domestic} mink.

Subject: Technical note on Senate Bill 81, LRB 0798/1, relating to display of license plates upon vehicles consigned for sale by dealers, distributors, and manufacturers

We'd like to just point out that the relating clause and the LRB analysis for SB 81 reference "transporters." However, the actual bill language does not include transporters.

The bill language is correct, because transporters are not allowed to sell vehicles and therefore should not be covered under this bill.

This just means that the relating clause and the LRB analysis are inconsistent with the bill. Thank you.
