Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill is remedial legislation recommended by the Law Revision Committee. It:

Clarifies that an employe who took leave from the classified service to take an appointment in the unclassified service has restoration rights, even if his appointment is to another agency.

Clarifies that an employe who runs for partisan office shall be placed on leave. The leave is not discretionary.

Repeals obsolete language regarding compensation for ADA's that covered a transitional group.

Removes a non-existing "Veterans Museum Superintendent" from the list of employes whose salaries are set by the appointing authority.

Deletes obsolete language regarding the appointment of local examiners.

Deletes obsolete language about solicitation of recommendations.

These changes will have no fiscal effect on the Department of Employment Relations.
