## **1999 WISCONSIN ACT 119**

AN ACT to amend 812.34 (1) (a) of the statutes; relating to: disposable earning exempt from garnishment.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 812.34 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

812.34 (1) (a) Was ordered by a court under s. 128.21 or by a court of bankruptcy any court of the United States under Title 11, USC 1301 to 1330.

## **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

(1) This act first applies to garnishment actions commenced on the effective date of this subsection.

## SECTION 3. Effective date.

(1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 4th month beginning after publication.
