Department staff has had the opportunity to review the proposed language in SB 241. In this process, an issue has been identified related to implementing the provisions of the bill. We thought it might be helpful to share this concern with you prior to the hearing on the bill next week.

The bill requires implementation of the provisions on the tenth day after publication of the bill. As I am sure Milwaukee Public Schools and others will share with you, immediate implementation would be logistically difficult, if not impossible. Because of how districts qualify, develop, and collect data (in essence, over a three-year period), you may want to consider a delayed effective date. For example, the following modifications might be considered:

- The definitions for children-at-risk, under s. 118.153(1), would become effective beginning in the 2000-01 school year.
- The program provision under s. 118.153(3) would first apply to students served in the 2000-01 school year.
- The change in the criteria for qualifying for reimbursement under s. 118.153(4) would begin with the annual report that is filed August 31, 2001.

I commend you and the other members of the Legislative Council Special Committee for your work on the Children At Risk program and your efforts to meet the needs of Wisconsin children who are at risk.
