I would like to submit a drafting request on behalf of Rep. Freese relating to organ donation. What we would like to do is require all drivers' education classes, school district and private for-profit organizations, to set aside up to 30 minutes of instruction to educate students about organ donation and donation procedures.

I have been working with an UW-medical student whose thesis is to put together a video and/or packet of information regarding organ donation. He is working with the UW-organ procurement people to help set this up. They would send this information out to all the school districts and private organizations at the cost of the information only.

I realize the language may be a little tricky in regards to what organizations get to share the information with the drivers' ed people, so I would appreciate your thoughts on this one. The med. student has assured me that the UW-procurement people are more than capable of putting the information together and getting it out, but do problems develop when we make schools pay for the information at-cost. Any Ideas?

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires all driver education courses offered by school districts, county children with disabilities education boards, technical college districts and driver schools to include at least 30 minutes of instruction relating to organ donation and organ donation procedures.
