Hi, Mark:

Please draft the following changes to AB 714. I'm not sure if they would constitute a simple or a substitute amendment. Please use your judgement; we'd like to avoid a sub if possible.

Page 2, lines 3 and 4:

Delete everything after the words "into the human body" on line 3.

Page 2, line 6:

Amend to read: *If not given prior authorization under (2)(a)2*, may use an epinephrine auto-injector to administer epinephrine to any pupil who **appears to be experiencing a severe allergic reaction** if...

Note: The Wisconsin Association of School Boards came up with this revision. I'm not sure if (2)(a)2 is the correct citing. WASB's lobbyist had instead referenced "subd (2) to 118.29, which is inexact. The intent behind the revision is to exclude the "911" requirement relating to treating students who already have written permission to store an epi pen at school.

Page 2, line 14; Page 3, lines 11, 13, 20 and 22: Delete all references to epinephrine or epinephrine auto-injectors. Epinephrine is a prescription drug, so to single it out from all other prescription drugs may be problematic.

I need these changes made ASAP, because there is a hearing on the bill early next week. I have to get all of our groups on the same page before then.
