Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law specifies the expiration date of certain motor vehicles registered on a biennial or 5-year basis. This bill eliminates specific expiration dates for the registration of certain motor vehicles registered on a biennial or 5-year basis.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 341.25 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 341.25 (1) (b) For each motorcycle or moped with a curb weight of 1,499 pounds
6 or less, except a specially designed vehicle under s. 341.067, which is designed for the
7 transportation of persons rather than property, a biennial fee of \$23. Registration
8 ~~plates issued under this paragraph expire on April 30 of even-numbered years.~~
