SECTION 4. 15.16 (1) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

15.16 (1) (f) One member who is a participant in the Wisconsin retirement
system and who is a technical college educational support personnel employe, as
defined in s. 40.02 (55g), or an educational support personnel employe, as defined in
s. 40.02 (22m), elected by participating employes meeting the same criteria.

SECTION 5. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Notwithstanding the length of terms or manner of appointment or election
specified for members of the employe trust funds board under section 15.16 (1)
(intro.) of the statutes, as affected by this act, the member specified under section
15.16 (1) (f) of the statutes, as created by this act, shall be initially appointed for a
term expiring on May 1, 2003.
