

11 2. ~~(b)~~ Two senators, one ^{recommended} appointed by the majority leader of the senate and one
12 appointed ^{recommended} by the minority leader of the senate. This ^{subdivision} ~~paragraph~~ does not apply after
13 June 30, 2003.

14 3. ~~(c)~~ Five members representing business, 3 of whom have general business
15 experience, one of whom has experience in agriculture and one of whom has
16 experience with technology.

17 4. ~~(d)~~ One resident of the city of West Allis, recommended by the mayor of West
18 Allis.

19 5. ~~(e)~~ Three ^{one} other members ^{is a} who ~~are~~ residents of this state.

20 6. ~~(f)~~ The secretary of agriculture, trade and consumer protection and the
21 secretary of tourism.

6 provide crowd and traffic control services related to events held at the state fair park,
7 including events associated with the Olympic Ice Training Center under s. 42.11.

14 the board who are initially appointed under section ^{15.445(4)(a) 1. to 5.} 15.98(1)(a) to (e) of the statutes,
15 as ^{affected} ~~created~~ by this act, are appointed and qualified, whichever is later.

16 (b) Notwithstanding the length of terms specified in section ^{15.445(4)(b)} 15.98(2) of the
17 statutes, as ^{affected} ~~created~~ by this act, the governor shall appoint the initial members of the
18 board under section ^{15.445(4)(a) 3. to 5.} 15.98(1)(c) to (e) of the statutes, as ^{affected} ~~created~~ by this act, for the
19 following terms:

20 1. One member under section ^{15.445(4)(a) 3.} 15.98(1)(e) of the statutes, as ^{affected} ~~created~~ by this act,
