**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill will require a formal hearing on the setting of bail and other conditions of release for persons arrested for various serious crimes against children. There will be some increase in hearing as a result. In some counties including Milwaukee the policy that would be established by this bill were it to be enacted is already the norm. There are no data indicating the number of additional hearings that this will cause but it is expected to be a very small number.


