
SUMMARY OF BILL - Under current law, the Department of Natural Resources may establish different fishing seasons for different types of fish, and the seasons may vary from water to water throughout the state. Under this bill, any fishing season established for bass must be the same throughout the state.

FISCAL IMPACT - None anticipated.

1. This bill would not affect relations with local units of government or other state agencies.
2. No liability or revenue fluctuations are anticipated.
3. No staffing is required by state or local units of government.
4. State DNR Law Enforcement personnel will enforce the law or subsequent administrative rule during the normal course of their duties.


