

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate					
This bill specifies that it is not employment discrimination if an educational agency refuses to employ or to terminate from employment an unpardoned felon whether or not the circumstances of the felony substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular job. State correctional institutions and secured juvenile correctional facilities are among the entities included in the definition of "educational agency". This change is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the Department of Corrections (DOC).
