Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:

This bill exempts from registration a vehicle that is more than 700 but less than 2,000 pounds, with 4 or more low-pressure tires and a cargo area, and used primarily off a highway.

These vehicles are not currently registered because, while they are too heavy to meet the definition of ATV under Chapter 23, Stats., they are not certified for highway use and therefore may not be registered. This bill has no impact on the Department of Transportation or the Transportation Fund.
