Current law prohibits a school district from starting the school term before September 1 unless in that school year the school board holds a public hearing and adopts a resolution approving an earlier start date. This bill provides that the school board may hold a public hearing and adopt the resolution in the calendar year in which the earlier starting date falls.  State Effect: None.  Local Effect: Since AB 641 allows the hearing to be held and the resolution to be adopted anytime in the calendar (rather than school) year in which the earlier commencement date falls, the bill will enhance local control by giving school boards a more reasonable time frame to obtain input and fully consider a resolution. This may reduce or eliminate administrative difficulties for school boards. However, the fiscal effect is unknown.
