Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would provide the Public Service Commission (PSC) authority to direct that the three nuclear power Entities in this state send their payments for the Federal Nuclear Waste fund to the State of Wisconsin. This authority would be invoked if the PSC deemed that the Federal Department of Energy was not meeting its obligations to dispose of waste or spent fuel. The cost to deposit and account these three annual payments to a state escrow fund will be insignificant.
