
Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides that the director of state courts must provide a prison impact assessment for any bill or bill draft that creates a felony or modifies the period of imprisonment for a felony. The impact assessment would include, among other items, an analysis of the impact on prosecutors, the state public defender and the courts. Enactment of this bill would have no fiscal effect on the State Public Defender's Office.
