Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:

This bill repeals the provision in current law that requires a person who has a vehicle registered in Wisconsin to notify DOT within 10 days, of a name or address change. The Department of Transportation uses the US Postal Service National Change of Address service for address changes, and the requirement for separate address change notification is superfluous. A name change is accomplished through a title transaction, and again the current statutory requirement is superfluous. This bill has no fiscal impact on the Department of Transportation or on the Transportation Fund.
