**Executive Order Number 383** 

Relating to a Special Session of the Legislature

**I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article IV, Section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin do hereby require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in the city of Madison, beginning at 3:00 P.M. solely to consider and act upon legislation relating to:

Creating a tax rebate for individuals, repealing the school property tax rent credit, reducing the amount that is available under the school levy tax credit and making an appropriation.
