



1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 488

September 28, 1999 - Introduced by Representatives WOOD, GUNDRUM, MEYER, SYKORA, GUNDERSON, MUSSER, PETTIS, RYBA and BRANDEMUEHL. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 167.31 (2) (d); and **to create** 167.31 (4) (g) of the statutes;
2 **relating to:** fishing with a bow and arrow near a roadway.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, with certain exceptions, no person may shoot an arrow from a bow from or across a highway or within 50 feet of the center of a roadway. This bill permits a person to shoot an arrow from a bow within 50 feet of the center of a roadway if the person does so while fishing with a bow and arrow. The bill does not affect the current law provision that prohibits a person from shooting an arrow from a bow from or across a highway.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 167.31 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 167.31 (2) (d) Except as provided in sub. (4) (a), (cg) ~~and~~, (e) and (g), no person
5 may discharge a firearm or shoot a bolt or an arrow from a bow or crossbow from or
6 across a highway or within 50 feet of the center of a roadway.

7 **SECTION 2.** 167.31 (4) (g) of the statutes is created to read:
