If you have any questions, please contact Brett in my office. Thank you again for your work on behalf of the people of Wisconsin and the State Assembly.

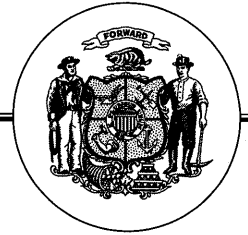

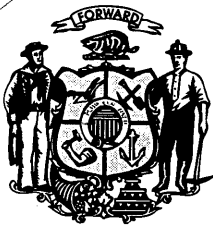



Waukesha County/Paul G. Vrakas

Mr. Vrakas, a lifelong resident of the City of Waukesha, has been a member of the Waukesha County Board since 1994. A former Mayor of the City of Waukesha, Mr. Vrakas currently chairs the County Board's Land Development Committee and serves on the Board's Finance and Public Works Committees. Mr. Vrakas, a long-time Waukesha restaurateur; was first elected Mayor of the City of Waukesha in 1970 and served in that office until 1978, when he decided to expand his restaurant business and did not seek reelection. In 1986, he sold his business and was again elected Mayor, serving in that office until 1994. Mr. Vrakas also served two terms as an Alderman on the Waukesha Common Council from 1960 to 1964. He chaired the City of Waukesha Plan Commission throughout his tenures as Mayor. A former member of the Board of Directors of the Wisconsin League of Municipalities, his special interest is in community development and environmental matters. Prior to starting his restaurant business in 1951, Mr. Vrakas attended Carroll College.

Mr. Vrakas, who served on the Regional Planning Commission from 1980 to 1986 after being appointed by Governor Lee Sherman Dreyfus, returned to the Commission in 1992 after Governor Tommy G. Thompson appointed him upon the nomination of Waukesha County. His current term on the Commission expires on September 15, 1998. He serves on the Commission's Administrative Committee and Planning and Research Committee.
