Dear Rep. Huebsch:

This is to advise you of our wish to register in support of Assembly Bill 23, relating to privacy impact statements. I have another meeting Tuesday, Feb. 15, which prevents me from attending the public hearing in Sturtevant. However, we wish to go on record in favor of this legislation, as introduced by Rep. Schneider.

Our members around the state believe that with today's ever-increasingly sophisticated means of gathering and disseminating data on individuals, the growing desire on the part of medical professionals and geneticists to have such information, and the inherent problems that underlie this practice, a bill such as AB 23 makes sense.

Environmental impact statements now are routinely required for many purposes where our lands, water or air may be affected. Surely a similar requirement for legislation that might impact the personal, health-related or even moral environment of individuals is equally important -- more so, actually.

For the record, we support legislation that would restrict the collection of medical, surgical or genetic information about individuals. Central to our sincerely held religious convictions is that an individual is made in the image and likeness of God -- whole, and without defects or limitations. For us, these issues really go deeper than just personal privacy; they relate to the very core of our practice of seeing man spiritually.

Thank you for considering this statement. We would ask that it be entered for the record, and given consideration as your committee discusses and ultimately takes action on this legislation.
