RE: Transportation bills

Per our recent phone conversation, listed below are the transportation-related bills we have introduced together that are waiting to be scheduled for action by the Senate. I would appreciate anything you can do to move these bills forward. Thank you.

Brandemuehl/Breske bills:

1. AB 54, relating to issuing dealer registration plates to motor vehicle salvage pools.
2. AB 55, relating to misuse of distinctive dealer registration plate by a motor vehicle dealer, distributor, transporter or manufacturer.
3. AB 56, relating to motor carriers and the single-state insurance registration system.
4. AB 57, relating to eligibility to operate commercial motor vehicles and the transport of hazardous materials.
5. AB 58, relating to administrative action against motor vehicle auction dealer's licenses.
6. AB 59, relating to motor vehicle registration expiration dates.
7. AB 136, relating to transferring appeals of certain determinations of the department of transportation from the division of hearing and appeals to the tax appeals commission.
8. AB 137, relating to older security interests in motor vehicles.
9. AB 206, relating to creating a permit authorizing the operation upon a highway of a specialized hauling rig that exceeds statutory size and weight limits.

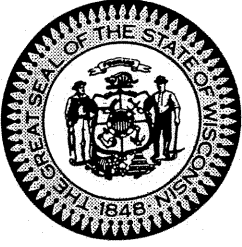

I would like to respectfully request your approval for the Assembly Transportation Committee to hold an executive session on two bills at 9:30 AM on Wednesday, May 19, 1999. The two bills are relatively non-controversial and the executive session should easily be completed before session begins at 10:00 AM.

The two bills under consideration are: AB 188, relating to exempting certain vehicles transporting material pumped from a septic or holding tank from special or seasonal weight limitations imposed by local highway authorities; and AB 206, relating to creating a permit authorizing the operation upon a highway of a specialized hauling rig that exceeds statutory size and weight limits.
