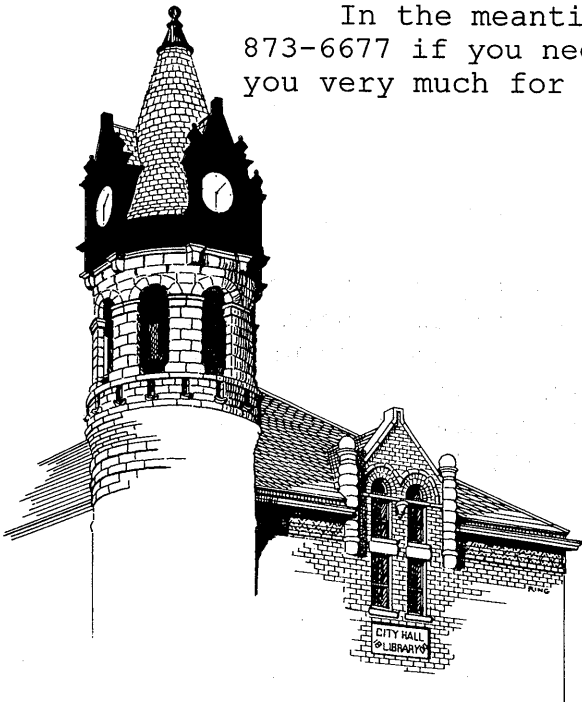

BILL SUMMARY

SB 409: City of Stoughton TIF District

Date: March 30, 2000

BACKGROUND

Under current law, when establishing a Tax Incremental Financing District (TID), a municipality must follow several procedures, including holding a public hearing. The last notice of the public hearing must be published at least 7 days prior to the hearing.

SUMMARY OF SB 409

SB 409 creates an exemption for the city of Stoughton in regards to the 7-day requirement of public notice. The last notice of the public hearing in the city of Stoughton for a TID was published 6 days before the hearing.

AMENDMENTS

Senate Amendment 1 (offered by Sen. Baumgart) corrects a reference to the year in which Sheboygan County was created.

FISCAL EFFECT

There is no fiscal effect.

PROS

1. Would allow the establishment of a TID created by the city of Stoughton to comply with state law.

CONS

1. Makes an exception to state law for an error made by the city of Stoughton.

SUPPORTERS

Sen. Robert Wirsch, author; Sen. Chuck Chvala; Rep Tom Hebl, lead co-sponsor; City of Stoughton.

OPPOSITION

None.

HISTORY

Senate Bill 409 was introduced on February 23, 2000, and referred to the committee on Economic Development, Housing and Government Operations. A public hearing was held on February 29, 2000. On February 29, 2000, the Committee voted 4-1 [Zien voting no] to recommend passage of SB 409. On March 7, 2000, the Senate adopted SA 1. On March 7, 2000, the Senate passed SB 409 28-5 and messaged their action to the Assembly. On March 9, 2000, the Assembly received SB 409 from the Senate and referred the bill to the

Committee on Ways and Means. A public hearing was held on March 22, 2000. On March 22, 2000, the Committee voted 15-0-1 [Rep Turner absent] to recommend concurrence of SB 409.
