I am pleased to present the Building Commission's recommended 1999-01 State Building Program to the Joint Committee on Finance for its review.

The Commission's recommendations are contained in two documents:

- 1) The Capital Budget Amendment to the 1999-01 Executive Budget Bill (LRBb0044/1). The jacketed copies have been hand-carried to the Legislative Fiscal Bureau.
