Dear Senator Risser and Representative Jensen:

The Legislative Reference Bureau recently forwarded a draft copy of the scheduling resolution for the 2001-02 biennial legislative session (LRB 0062/P1). The purpose of our letter is to inform you of our concerns about the draft and to offer our suggestions to improve the session schedule.

As chairs of the Joint Committee on Finance, it is our goal to complete the Committee's work on the budget by early June and provide ample time for the caucuses of both houses to discuss the bill and for the budget to be adopted by the beginning of the new fiscal year. To accomplish that goal, we believe that the following changes should be made to this draft.

First, the draft would extend the date of introduction of the biennial budget from the statutory date (January 30 in 2001) to February 15. This should be deleted from the resolution. The budget process should begin on time.

Second, the LRB draft contains a three-week floorperiod in March, none in April and then a lengthy floorperiod that would begin in mid-May and continue through June. In order for the Finance Committee to conclude its deliberations in a timely fashion, extensive Committee executive sessions need to be conducted throughout the month of May and the beginning of June. To accommodate this, we ask that the floorperiod which begins on March 6 should include the week of March 12 and extend through April 5. The May floorperiod of the draft should be eliminated and the June floorperiod should begin on June 12.

We believe that the changes that we have suggested will be beneficial to the legislative process and would ask that they be incorporated into the final scheduling resolution.

Thank you for your consideration of our request.
