SUBJECT: 1999 Senate Bill 8, Relating to Hours of Sales by Intoxicating Liquor Wholesalers

1999 Senate Bill 8 was introduced on January 20, 1999 by Senator George. The Senate Committee on Economic Development, Housing and Government Operations will conduct a public hearing on Senate Bill 8 on September 2, 1999.

PROVISIONS OF 1999 SENATE BILL 8

Under current law, the premises of a licensed intoxicating liquor wholesaler *may not be open* for the sale of liquor *between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.*, except on Saturday when the premises may remain open until 9:00 p.m.

Senate Bill 8 allows intoxicating liquor wholesalers to *remain open for business until 9:00 p.m.* daily.

Senate Substitute Amendment 1, introduced by Senator George on May 18, 1999, makes the provisions of the bill *applicable only to first class cities*, that is, the City of Milwaukee.
