1999 Senate Bill 99, Relating to Certain Statutes Dealing With Motor Vehicle

Dealers, Salespersons and Sales Finance Companies (Revision Bill)

1999 Senate Bill 99 was introduced on March 25, 1999 by the Law Revision Committee at the request of the Revisor of Statutes. A public hearing on the bill is scheduled for January 4, 2000.

### A. BACKGROUND

The 1971 Legislature created s. 218.01, Stats., which regulates the retail motor vehicle industry in Wisconsin. Specifically, the statute regulates the operations and activities of motor vehicle dealers, salespersons and sales finance companies, including the licensing of motor vehicle dealerships. Original s. 218.01, Stats., comprised 11 pages of the statutes. Subsequent legislative enactments have increased the length of s. 218.01 to 17 pages.

The evolution and increasing complexity of s. 218.01 prompted the Revisor of Statutes to request the introduction of an earlier version of the above-captioned legislation late in the 1997 Session, which did not pass. The Law Revision Committee subsequently reintroduced this legislation as 1999 Senate Bill 99 early in the current session.

### **B. PROVISIONS OF BILL**

1999 Senate Bill 99 converts present s. 218.01 into 32 separate sections of the statutes, thereby dividing the current statute into a more workable and understandable format. In addition, cross-references contained in other statutes to various provisions of s. 218.01 are revised to reflect these changes.

The definitions in the old statute are also modified to reflect current drafting style and format; and other language has been modified to conform with more modern drafting style, primarily to replace general or nonspecific references with specific references.

According to the Revisor of Statutes, *no substantive changes* are contained in the bill. Also, the bill contains an extensive 12 page table showing the relationship between the renumbered statutes contained in the bill and the statutory numbering contained in present s. 218.01.
