Thank you for responding to my request regarding the schedule for the pending hearing on AB 432. Enclosed is a copy of my testimony supporting AB 432 at the hearing before the Assembly Committee on Colleges and Universities. Also enclosed is the UW's testimony which was *supposed* to be neutral and factual.

The third paragraph of VP Lewis' statement said, "Without evidence of financial hardship it is difficult to justify providing the additional benefit without a fee." Her report doesn't account for the 75.6 % drop in enrollment since the fee policy was instituted. Many of the University administrators and the Board of Regents have no financial hardship but that didn't stop them from enjoying a freebie to the Rose Bowl.

The fee policy at some of the other Big Ten Schools according to calls I made last month differ from her statement. At Illinois, seniors over 65 pay no fees, those under 64 pay \$15 per course. At Indiana, everyone pays \$15 per credit. At Minnesota, auditing for no credit is free for seniors 62+ and \$9 per credit for credit. At Penn State, auditing is free for evening classes.

In September 1993, GOOD HOUSEKEEPING magazine did a survey of 69 state supported schools; 47% were free, 32% were \$25 or less, 21% were \$30 or more. UW was fourth from the most expensive at \$79 for a three credit course. At today's rates, a three credit course at Madison and Milwaukee is \$126.

Lewis' claim of \$60,200 loss in revenue is somewhat inflated since it is based on the current fee times last year's enrollment. Extrapolating next year's enrollment based on the decrease in enrollment over the last five years would reduce the loss to about \$50,000. But rather than considering this a loss, it should be considered an investment in future returns by seniors leaving money to the UW. After all, the good will created by the free policy may result in good WILLS.

Lewis also claimed if there was no offset in the budget for this loss, UW System would have to raise tuition on other students. A representative of the student association, Joe Northwood, from LaCrosse testified that he encouraged and welcomed senior citizens into the classroom and was willing to pay the increase in tuition.

Incidentally, if tuition was increased, each student would have to give up a few sips of beer.

I hope the committee on Education and the Senate will pass AB 432 unanimously as was done in the Assembly. Unanimous approval should help Governor Thompson sign this bill.

AB 432 will restore the 1975-1990 free senior auditing policy. Since 1991, when the UW Regents voted for a fee, which is now \$42 per credit in Madison, the UW System enrollment has decreased from 2012 TO 491, or 75.6%. This poor statistic is not only unsatisfactory for seniors but detrimental to the University of Wisconsin System.

In a 1990 UW System policy discussion paper appears the following statement: "While it is true that many senior citizens are not economically disadvantaged, it seems appropriate for the UW System to recognize the long term support Wisconsin residents have provided and to encourage lifelong learning with a tangible benefit. An additional consideration is the potential for ill-will that could be fostered by taking away a benefit that has been provided at little cost to the UW System for many years."

Obviously, the current policy is not working. In reply to one of many letters from seniors protesting the policy change, Chancellor Donna Shalala said in March 1991, "Clearly, many Wisconsin residents will feel that they have lost an important senior citizen fringe benefit. If the new policy results in diminished numbers of seniors enrolling as auditors, then we and our students will have lost something of value as well. Time will have to be the test of the wisdom of this new policy".

Regent Vice President Albert O. Nicholas said in February 1993, "We are simply driving auditors away and thereby creating a lot of bad will and ill will among our senior citizens. I believe it was an overreaction to the nonresident auditors in Madison and has done more harm than good".

Past Chancellor Lee Grugel of the UW Centers said in October 1994, "The free audit was a useful policy for the UW Centers, one that promoted good will in our communities among seniors who support us through their income and property taxes, as well as in more indirect ways. Their presence in our classrooms also frequently enriched discussion, and thus benefited our more traditional students as well".

Past Chancellor John H. Schroeder of UW Milwaukee said in October 1995, "Senior auditors at UW-Milwaukee have decreased by 65.7% since 1990 when the current policy of charging \$30 per credit was implemented. However, the numbers illustrate only part of what UWM has lost in the past five years. Our experience here is that the presence of senior auditors enhances the quality of the course for all students in a particular class".

Chancellor Judith L Kuipers of UW-La Crosse said in October 1995, "The participation of this older segment of our society is extremely valuable to our younger students and our faculty as well as a quality-of-life issue for seniors".

Chancellor David Ward of UW-Madison said in October 1995, "I support class access for senior citizens at reasonable cost and agree that our Wisconsin seniors have contributed greatly in many ways to the quality of this University. President Lyall is well aware, too, of these contributions and the impact of the seniors on our campuses".

Director Carol D. Ryff of the Wisconsin Institute on Aging said in November 1997, "I am convinced that continued educational pursuits constitute one of the most important routes to successful aging. The learning experience is a powerful means of keeping aging minds vital, and extensive scientific work now documents that mental abilities of older adults can be maintained, or even improved, with properly stimulating environments and opportunities. Making our centers of learning places where aged individuals can be vital participants seems a very fruitful direction to take, both for the well being of the universities and that of the older population".

Many people wrote letters to the Board of Regents complaining about the policy change. These were ignored. In addition, I collected petitions with 769 signatures requesting the Regents to change the policy. They were ignored.

Past President Regent Michael Grebe said one of the top priority issues to be considered is access and affordability. The present policy does neither.

**Testimony on Assembly Bill 432  
Assembly Colleges and Universities Committee**

Thank you Chairman Kreibich and members of the committee. I am Associate Vice President Margaret Lewis speaking today for information only on behalf of the UW System. Assembly Bill 432 requires the Board of Regents and the Wisconsin Technical College System board to allow a Wisconsin resident who is 60 years or older to audit a course without paying an auditor's fee if space is available and the instructor approves.

Currently, the UW System offers a 70% tuition discount to all residents, regardless of age, who audit courses at any UW System institution, as space is available. An exception is provided to disabled Wisconsin residents receiving governmental disability benefits who are not charged an audit fee.

While students enrolled for credit are being required to pay an increasing share of their educational costs, it seems appropriate for others benefiting from academic programs through auditing, to contribute a small amount to maintaining the quality of the program offered. Without evidence of financial hardship it is difficult to justify providing the additional benefit without a fee.

Other Midwestern states assess auditing fees for senior citizens in a variety of ways.

Four Big Ten institutions (Illinois, Iowa, Indiana, Michigan State) have no special policy; senior auditors pay the full tuition (no fees). (Note: Illinois does have a tuition waiver policy for seniors who take courses for credit.)

Four other institutions have a special senior auditor policy: Michigan: 50% reduction at age 65, Minnesota: \$9 per semester per credit at age 62, Ohio State: full tuition waiver at age 60, and Purdue: 50% reduction at age 60 for retired, high school graduates.

Finally, the statutes give the Board of Regents responsibility for setting tuition/academic fee policies. They meet monthly and are closest to information about program quality needs and competitive factors. The policy on auditing courses was adopted by the Regents in June 1991, after extensive discussion and public debate. The bill would decrease tuition/fee revenues without providing replacement GPR revenue. When other tuition reduction bills were passed in recent years, for example, for the spouses and children of slain officers, replacement revenue has been provided even though the annual amount was small. If this bill were enacted without funding, the UW System would sustain a base budget reduction of about \$60,200 or would need to replace these revenues by increasing tuition/fees on other students.

The Legislature may wish to consider creating a financial aid program for the approximately \$40 per credit (generally about \$120 per class) cost of auditing a course. The current 70% discount for auditors does not seem overly burdensome. There remain many students working toward their first degree who have significant unmet financial need. With limited resources, continuing to serve needy students is the Board of Regents' first priority.

While students enrolled for credit are being required to pay an increasing share of their educational costs, it seems appropriate for others benefiting from academic programs through auditing, to contribute a small amount to maintaining the quality of the program offered. Without evidence of financial hardship it is difficult to justify providing the additional benefit without a fee.

Other Midwestern states assess auditing fees for senior citizens in a variety of ways.

Wisconsin auditors are charged less than five other Big Ten institutions. Iowa, Indiana, and Michigan State have no special policy; senior auditors in Michigan receive a 50% reduction at age 65, and Purdue allows a 50% reduction at age 60 for retired, high school graduates.

Three institutions have a special senior auditor policy: Minnesota: free audition and \$9 per credit when taking the course for credit at age 62, Ohio State: full tuition waiver at age 60, and Illinois: full tuition waiver at age 65 (\$15 per credit under age 65.)

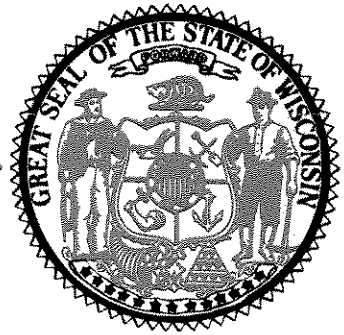
