Re: LRB-3933/1, relating to the State Fair Park Board, authorizing the creation of private corporations to provide support for the State Fair Park, construction and leasing of buildings, structures and facilities at the State Fair Park and making an appropriation.

We are introducing legislation to amend and create new statutory provisions, which would govern the management and operation of the State Fair Park.

Governor Thompson, in the State of the State address, set forth a bold vision for a revised and renewed State Fair Park. Governor Thompson's recommendations are based upon the findings of a State Fair Park Strategic Development Committee, appointed by the Governor to find ways to expand and upgrade the use of State Fair Park. These new statutory provisions are also part of the State Fair Park Strategic Development Committee Plan.

This legislation is recommended by the Strategic Development Committee to ensure that the state's investment at State Fair Park will be properly maintained and managed for many years to come.
