



SENATOR BRESKE TO HOLD SENATE TOURISM HEARING IN GREEN BAY *School start bill and budget issues scheduled for public input*

MADISON – State Senator Roger Breske (D-Eland) will be holding a public hearing of the Senate Committee on Insurance, Tourism, Transportation and Corrections in Green Bay on Thursday, April 1, 1999. Legislation establishing a uniform school start date for Wisconsin's public schools and other budget matters are scheduled for public testimony before the committee. An official notice is attached for your reference.

As Chair of the committee, Breske has scheduled the hearing to discuss Senate Bills 13 and the Governor's proposed budget. According to the Eland Democrat, SB13 would prohibit school districts from starting their fall semesters before September 1st. It is identical to legislation that he has introduced in previous sessions. The committee will also accept public testimony on the Governor's budget proposal relating to Insurance, Tourism, Transportation or Corrections.

The meeting will take place in the City Council Chambers of the Green Bay City Hall located at 100 North Jefferson Street from 1:00PM to 4:00 PM.
