<b>Assembly Bill 37</b>	Relating to burglary and providing a penalty.	Passed Assembly Criminal Justice Committee 9-4. Passed the full Assembly on a voice vote.
<b>Assembly Bill 109</b>	Relating to release of persons arrested for certain crimes against children.	Passed Assembly Judiciary and Personal Privacy Committee 9-0. Passed the full Assembly 95-0.
<b>Assembly Bill 72</b>	Relating to the disclosure of juvenile records by a juvenile court or a municipal court.	Passed the Assembly Children and Families Committee 10-0. Passed the full Assembly 97-0.

**I would greatly appreciate it if you would schedule these bills for a public hearing in your committee.** They have been referred to the Senate for the last 10 months and had bi-partisan support in the Assembly.
