
Assembly Bill (AB) 335 was recently passed on a voice vote by the Assembly and was referred to the Senate Judiciary and Consumer Affairs Committee, which you chair. I am requesting that you hold a hearing on the bill at your earliest convenience.

I introduced AB 335 at the request of the Wisconsin Municipal Judges Association to allow municipal courts to hold refusal hearings for municipal OWI offenses. Current law states that a refusal hearing for a municipal OWI must be heard before the circuit court. As a result, there are two different courts handling the same case. Passage of AB 335 would save time and money and lessen confusion between the two court systems.

RE: AB 335 – Relating to allowing municipal courts to hold refusal hearings

I am writing to request that you schedule AB 335 on the Judiciary and Consumer Affairs agenda for the next committee hearing to be held on 11/9/99.

Current law holds that if a person is cited for a first offense OWI municipal court violation and refuses to submit to a BAC test, the OWI charge is held in municipal court while the refusal hearing must be held in the county circuit court where the offense occurred. This bill allows the municipal court to handle both proceedings.
