He called in response to message sent on 3-13-00, to Judy
Norman-Nunnery, Administrator, of the Worker's Compensation
Advisory Council, advising her that the bill was in the Senate
Labor Committee and asked if the Council had looked at it or
would be. Dick said Reps Vrakas & Powers also contacted the
department and requested the Council to look at the bill.

The Council will be discussing the bill & subject at their April
24th meeting. There are problems with the bill and it needs to
be worked on to be incorporated in the "agreed upon" yearly
Worker's Comp bill for next year.

Dane County is the group pushing the legislation & Smith has
talked to a Charity in Falk's Office.
