1 AN ACT *for act*; relating to: requiring the elections board to make recommendations
2 regarding the issuance of voter identification cards to electors in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

4 (1) The elections board shall prepare recommendations with regard to issuing
5 voter identification cards to electors in this state. No later than the first day of the
6 7th month beginning after the effective date of this subsection, the elections board
7 shall submit the recommendations to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature
8 for distribution to the appropriate standing committees of the legislature in the
9 manner provided under section 13.172 (3) of the statutes.
