- 2 positions for city, village, and town elective officeholders.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a volunteer fire fighter, emergency medical technician, or first responder in a city, village, or town whose annual compensation, including fringe benefits, does not exceed \$2,500 may also hold elected office in that city, village, or town. This bill increases the annual compensation limit to \$15,000.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 66.0501 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 66.0501 (4) Compatible offices and positions. A volunteer fire fighter,
- 5 emergency medical technician or first responder in a city, village or town whose
- 6 annual compensation, including fringe benefits, does not exceed \$2,500 the amount
