This redraft makes the capitalization and punctuation changes that you requested. Before introducing the draft, however, I would suggest that you run it past the composer as the initial draft was faithful to the punctuation and capitalization originally set forth by the composer. Although it appears ungrammatical to capitalize words in the middle of a sentence, capitalizing those words signifies that the words would start a new line if the text were printed in its original verse form. See, for example, s. 1.10, stats., which sets forth the words of "On Wisconsin".
