1 AN ACT to amend 125.51 (3) (e) 2. of the statutes; relating to: the fee for initial
2 issuance of a reserve "Class B" license.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires each municipality to establish a fee for the initial issuance of a reserve "Class B" license, which authorizes the sale of intoxicating liquor on or off the premises where sold. With specific exceptions, current law prescribes a minimum fee of \$10,000 for the initial issuance of the license, but prescribes no maximum amount for the fee. The fee is payable to the municipality issuing the license.

Under this bill, the fee for initial issuance of a reserve "Class B" license is an amount established by the issuing municipality, but not less than \$500 nor more than ~~\$1,000~~ \$10,000

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
