"Section 1g. 196.218 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

196.218 (3) (b) The commission may exempt from part or all of the contributions required under par. (a) telecommunications providers who have small gross operating revenues from the provision of intrastate telecommunications services in this state and who have provided these services for less than a period specified by the commission, not to exceed 5 years. The commission may also exempt a telecommunications provider or other person from part or all of the contribution required under par. (a) if the commission determines that requiring the contribution would not be in the public interest.".

2. Page 2, line 1: delete "Section 1" and substitute "Section 1r".

Page 2, line 4: after the period insert "A surcharge established under this paragraph shall be printed conspicuously in plain English on a billing statement and may not exceed the amount that a telecommunications provider or other person is required to contribute to the universal service fund under this subsection. A telecommunications provider or other person may not establish a surcharge under this paragraph unless the telecommunications provider or other person provides written notice to its customers not less than 30 days hor more than 90 days before establishing the surcharge. The notice may be given as part of a regular billing statement to a customer. No more than 30 days after receiving the notice, a customer may cancel, without penalty, the contract for telecommunications services to which the surcharge would apply."
