

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 36**

January 23, 2001 – Offered by Representative COLON.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 1: after “program” insert “, prohibiting the department of health  
3 and family services from requiring that an individual be a U.S. citizen to be eligible  
4 for health care coverage under the badger care health care program,”.

5 **2.** Page 1, line 3: delete that line and substitute:

6 “**SECTION 1d.** 49.665 (4) (a) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

7 49.665 **(4)** (a) 4. The family meets all other requirements established by the  
8 department by rule. In establishing other eligibility criteria, the department may  
9 not include any health condition requirements or require that an individual or any  
10 member of the individual’s family be a U.S. citizen.

11 **SECTION 1g.** 49.665 (4) (am) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

12 49.665 **(4)** (am) 4. The child meets all other requirements established by the  
13 department by rule. In establishing other eligibility criteria, the department may

1 not include any health condition requirements or require that an individual or any  
2 member of the individual's family be a U.S. citizen.

3 **SECTION 2m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) BADGER CARE HEALTH CARE PROGRAM WAIVER. Not later than January 1, 2002,  
5 the department of health and family services shall request a waiver from the federal  
6 secretary of health and human services to permit the department to use federal  
7 moneys received under 42 USC 1397aa to 1397jj and federal moneys received for  
8 providing medical assistance under subchapter IV of chapter 49 of the statutes, to  
9 provide health care coverage to individuals who are not U.S. citizens as provided  
10 under section 49.665 (4) (a) 4. and (am) 4. of the statutes, as affected by this act.

11 **SECTION 3m. Appropriation changes.”.**
