1 AN ACT...; relating to: development of a statewide, centralized, computerized

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

shall submit

4 (1) Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) of the statutes, the elections board shall
5 as a part of its budget request for the 2003-05 fiscal biennium
6 propose under section 16.42 of the statutes a statewide, centralized voter
7 registration and poll list system in its budget request for fiscal biennium 2003-04.

8 The proposed system shall be computerized, shall require voter registration in every
9 municipality in this state, shall be maintained by the elections board, and shall allow
10 for the real-time entering and checking of voter registration and polling information
by election officials, so as to facilitate the elimination of multiple voting by the same

1 elector at the same election. The proposed system shall be designed to be operational
2 as of the 2004 spring election.
