Please note that the attached amendment appears to relate to the type of identification a person must present in order to vote rather than to voter registration. Thus, the amendment may have been intended to modify the nonstatutory provision on page 7 of AB–49 dealing with voter identification and not the nonstatutory provision on page 6 dealing with voter registration. If the amendment is intended to modify the provision on page 7, you may also want to reconcile the amendment with AA–6 to AB–49, which deleted the specific reference to voter identification cards and replaced it with a general reference to voter identification.
