5	SECTION 1. 44.70 (3c) and (3e) of the statutes are created to read:
6	44.70 (3c) "Harmful to children" means that quality of any description,
7	narrative account, or representation, in whatever form, of nudity, as defined in s.
8	948.11 (1) (d), sexually explicit conduct, sexual excitement, as defined in s. 948.11 (1)
9	(f), sadomasochistic abuse, physical torture, or brutality, that does all of the
10	following:

a. Predominantly appeals to the prurient, shameful, or morbid interest of

publication.

1	b. Is patently offensive to prevailing standards in the adult community as a
2	whole with respect to what is suitable for children.
3	c. Lacks serious literary, artistic, political, scientific, or educational value for
4	children, when taken as a whole.
5	(3e) "Internet management software or services" means software or services
6	that are used to filter or block access to material on the Internet that is harmful to
7	children.
8	SECTION 2. 44.72 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:
9	44.72 (2) (d) A school district receiving a grant under par. (b) shall deposit the
10	moneys in a separate fund. The moneys may be used for any purpose related to
11	educational technology, including obtaining the Internet management software or
12	services specified in s. 44.73 (7), except that a school district may not use the moneys
13	to pay the salary or benefits of any school district employee.
14	SECTION 3. 44.73 (7) of the statutes is created to read:
15	44.73 (7) A school district is not eligible to participate in the program
16	established under sub. (1) or to receive a grant under sub. (6) unless the school
17	district provides Internet management software or services on all computers that are
18	owned by the school district, connected to the Internet, and used by pupils.
19	Section 4. Effective date.
