Re: 2001 AB 57 which would create a sales and use tax exemption for nonprescription drugs

We received a copy of the February 14th memo the Department of Revenue for you suggesting some changes to AB 57.

Rep. Black asks you to prepare an amendment to incorporate two of the three changes the agency recommends... changing the word "nonnarcotic drug" to simply "drug" and to limit the exemption to drugs for human consumption only.

Rep. Black does not wish to include funding for DOR to administer the changes required if AB 57 becomes law.

February 1, 2001 - Introduced by Representatives BLACK, URBAN, GRONEMUS, GROTHMAN, MORRIS-TATUM, BOCK, POWERS, HUBER, BOYLE, YOUNG, GUNDERSON, J. LEHMAN, MEYERHOFER, CARPENTER, LASSA, POCAN, BALOW, BERCEAU and WILLIAMS, cosponsored by Senators BAUMGART and M. MEYER. Referred to Joint survey committee on Tax Exemptions.

1 AN ACT to create 77.54 (14v) of the statutes; relating to: a sales and use tax
2 exemption for nonprescription drugs.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for nonprescription drugs.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on tax exemptions for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 77.54 (14v) of the statutes is created to read:

4 77.54 (14v) The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use, or other

5 consumption of nonnarcotic drugs which may be sold without a prescription and

6 which are prepackaged for use by consumers, and labeled in accordance with the

7 requirements of state and federal law.

8 SECTION 2. Effective date.
